

About the Position: The Office of Women's Health, Healthy Moms/Healthy Babies (HM/HB) Program of Mississippi is seeking to candidates for Nurse II. The Nurse II is professional Registered Nurse accountable for serving as primary nurse case manager for the Healthy Moms/Healthy Babies of Mississippi Program. The functional duties of the primary nurse case manager include but are not limited to the following: Providing case management services, screenings, assessments, care plans, community outreach and care coordination to expectant mothers, infants up to 1 years of age and families in the MS State Department of Health, Healthy Moms/Healthy Babies of MS program. The Nurse II is accountable for overseeing complex or sensitive care of patients through care coordination, assessments and creation of plans of care. Will be a member and lead of a multidisciplinary care management team. These services are delivered in the home and clinic settings.

Supervision: No direct reports.

What You'll Need to be Successful: The ideal candidate will have experience in effectively managing multiple competing high stakes demands simultaneously. Must have strong people skills and the ability to skillfully collaborate on and coordinate activities for individual patients. They should be able to work autonomously and with a team. The employee should have good time management and organizational skills. The employee should be culturally sensitive and exhibit problem solving and conflict resolution skills. Must have knowledge of community resources and use that knowledge effectively to assist clients and/or patients as needed. Must take initiative to learn new skills, knowledge, and processes as changes arise routinely. The ability to easily adapt and be flexible to unexpected changes in routine is necessary.
