

Investigator II, MS08 (WIC Program Monitoring and Compliance Support)

About the Position: The Mississippi State Department of Health WIC Program is seeking to fill one (1) Investigator II position. The Investigator II position will work with the WIC Program as a Vendor Monitoring and Compliance Support Analyst. This position is accountable for activities related to eWIC vendors, including retail grocery stores and pharmacies. Activities include but are not limited to performing vendor spot checks, follow-ups, documenting vendor related issues appropriately, investigating participant complaints, and providing technical assistance and support to eWIC vendors.

Preferred Qualifications: Typically requires a Bachelor's Degree and 2-4 years of investigative experience in one or all of the following areas; fraud, asset protection or inventory controls.
