#### **Regulations Reminder**

April is here! So please remember to include Sun Safety Practices into your activities. For your convenience we have include the rules for you to review as is related to Sun Safety.

- Subchapter 9: Program of Activities: Rule 1.9.1 (3) The child care facility shall incorporate programs to encourage sun safety practices (skin cancer prevention), into activities for all age levels.
- Rule 1.9.5 (3) Sun safe practices shall be used during outdoor activities scheduled between 10 A.M. and 2 P.M. during the period of April1 to September 15.
  - Rule 1.9.5 (4) Sun safe practices shall be evident in the planning of all outdoor events.


