What is Comprehensive Cancer Control?

- Comprehensive Cancer Control (CCC) is a collaborative process through which a community pools resources to reduce the burden of cancer that results in risk reduction, early detection, better treatment, and enhanced survivorship.
- These efforts encourage healthy lifestyles, increase access to quality cancer care, and improve quality of life for cancer survivors.



Mississippi Partnership for Comprehensive Cancer Control – MP3C

- A statewide coalition formed to address cancer issues in a coordinated and comprehensive manner
- Over 100 organizations and individuals involved
- Goal to develop and implement a state Comprehensive Cancer Control Plan for Mississippi
- MSDH CCC program has received grant for planning and implementation from CDC since 2003



MP3C Mission Statement

- **Reduce the human suffering and economic burden of cancer for Mississippi's citizens by developing, implementing and evaluating a comprehensive cancer control plan.**



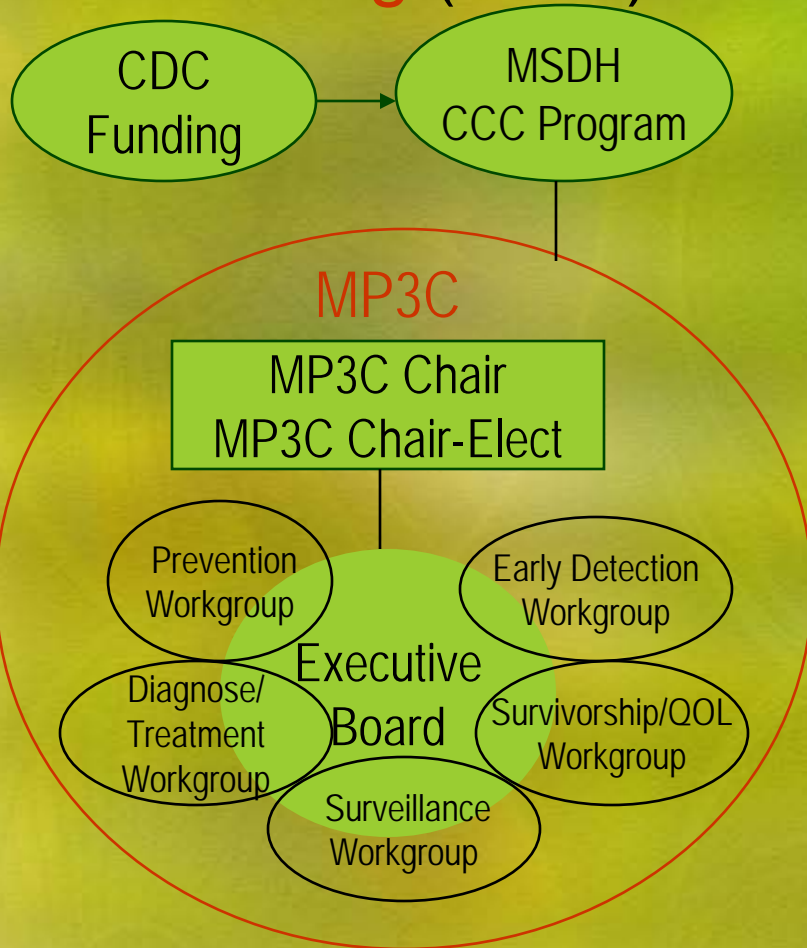
Mississippi Comprehensive Cancer Control Plan (2006~2010)

- MP3C structure developed in August 2003
- Recruitment kickoff held in December 2003
- Coalition workgroups developed around the continuum of cancer
- Stakeholders were invited for drafting the plan
- The CCC Plan (2006~2011) developed and published in May 2006
- Stakeholders were invited to identify the priorities for implementation
- Implementation structure add evaluation committee
- Implement CCC Plan in 2007

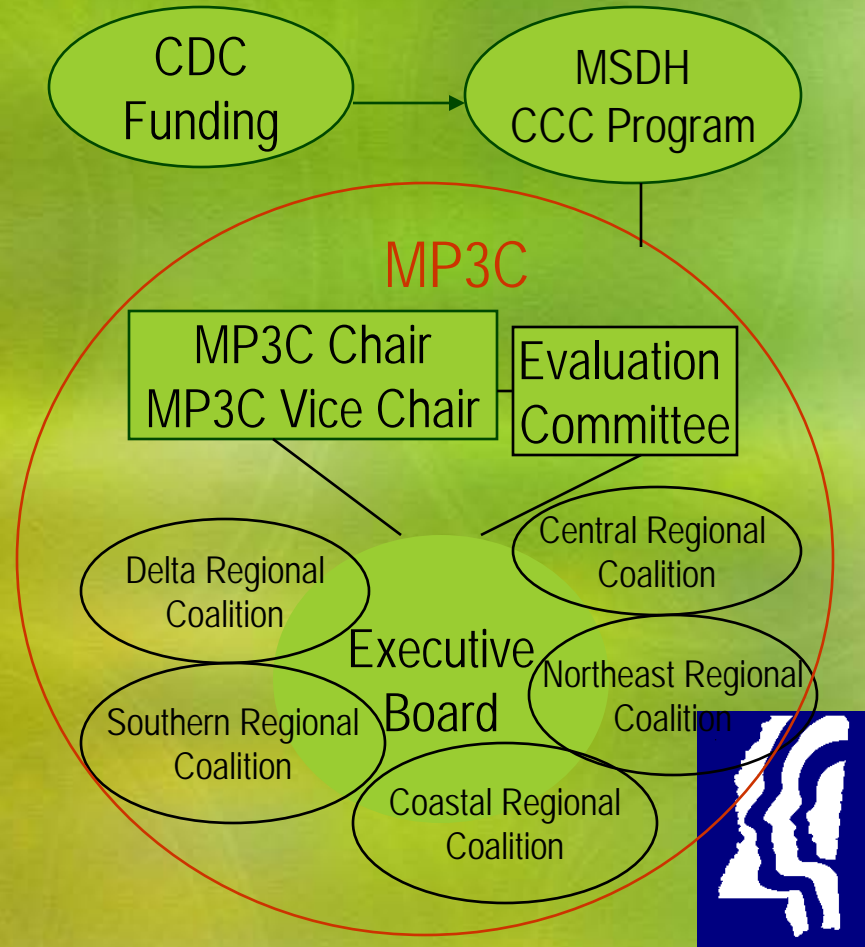


MP3C Structure (as of August 2009)
