Re: Rescission of Emergency CON (ESRD-ES-1025-010) and Continuation of CON Review (ESRD-ES-1125-011) Bio-Medical Applications of Mississippi, Inc. d/b/a Fresenius Kidney Care Jackson; Location: Jackson, Hinds County, Mississippi; Capital Expenditure: \$1,874,050.88

Dear Mr. Lesley:

The Department previously approved an Emergency Certificate of Need (CON) for Fresenius Kidney Care Jackson (CON Review ESRD-ES-1025-010) to temporarily add fifteen (15) ESRD stations at Fresenius North Jackson, based on the representation that eviction from the St. Dominic campus was imminent and the building Fresenius currently occupies was declared condemned *via* a structural engineer's determination that it is unsafe.

Our review has determined:

- Eviction has not occurred and remains uncertain.
- St. Dominic offered Fresenius options to purchase or lease land or relocate within one mile of the current site.
- Fresenius continues operating in the building deemed “condemned,” despite safety concerns.
- These facts were not disclosed in your application.

Accordingly, the Department intends to rescind the Emergency CON (ESRD-ES-1025-010) and proceed with the review of CON ESRD-ES-1125-011. Notice of this action will be posted on the MSDH website and provided to affected parties.

The review of CON ESRD-ES-1125-011 will proceed under the existing hearing schedule established for the regular CON application process.
